

# KINDER-CAMP

## A fun way for your preschooler to get ready for Kindergarten!

KinderCamp is a camp for children who will be entering Kindergarten in the fall, who may or may not have preschool experience. Kindergarten is full of activity for little hands, and this group is designed to provide an introduction to these activities, while having fun! This camp focuses on the development of fine motor and eye-hand coordination skills, as well as the development of core and upper extremity strengthening, which is the foundation for fine motor precision. Children will practice these skills in an enjoyable, encouraging, and engaging environment. Daily snack time will provide additional opportunities to work on important fine motor skills. Each day, the children will take home an activity that they have made in camp, that they can use at home to continue to build their fine motor skills all summer long and into the next school year!

The camp will be created and led by a licensed occupational therapist in partnership with pre-OT students. A maximum of 8 children will be enrolled for each camp session.
